







Columbia's free home weatherization program that is designed to help income eligible customers realize a safer, more comfortable home, reduce natural gas usage and save on energy bills.

Free services to owners or renters with household income at or below 150% FPG - Household of 4 making \$36,375 would qualify

Landlords of Nelsonville residential properties pay a maximum of \$500 toward heating unit replacement

Targets PIPP Plus and income eligible high natural gas usage households

Single Family / Multi Family up 4 units







Program Features

- Diagnostic and visual inspection identifies and addresses health and safety issues; opportunities for energy efficiency
- Gas appliances, including interior gas lines
- Blower door testing identifies and guides cost effective air leakage work and tightness levels of the home
- Infrared thermography and visual inspection determine insulation levels







Program Features - continued

- Weatherization and heating work performed by Hocking - Athens - Perry Community Action
- All work receives a quality assurance inspection upon completion









Program Measures

Insulation

- Attic and sidewalls
- Floors and ducts in unconditioned spaces

Strategic Air Leakage Sealing

Natural Gas Heating Systems/Natural Gas Water Heaters

- Repair/replacement of unsafe heating systems, including venting
- Repair/replacement of unsafe natural gas water heater, including venting
- High efficiency equipment installed







Program Stats

- Since 1987 over 61,377 customers serviced through WarmChoice®
- Among the highest natural gas savings in the nation
- Over the past 10 years, average natural gas savings per customer of over 320 ccfs







AEP Ohio Community Assistance Program

AEP Ohio funds this program to supplement state and federal incomequalified weatherization programs

Program Design

- Eligible clients enrolled in Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP),
 Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP), or Home Energy
 Assistance Program (HEAP); and
- Your gross income at or below 200% of poverty (Family of 4=\$47,700)







AEP Ohio Community Assistance Program

Program Measures

- Eligible clients may receive
 - A home energy assessment
 - Compact Florescent Lights (CFL;s)
 - Refrigerator/freezer replacement
 - Attic and wall insulation (if deemed cost effective)
 - Air sealing (if deemed cost effective)
 - Other energy-saving improvements

Designed to improve the electric efficiency of low-income households who participate in or are eligible for PIPP Plus

Program Design

- In-Home audits and installation of appropriate electric energy efficiency measures
- Consumer education helps client benefit while learning how to reduce amount of energy used







Program Eligibility

- Be income eligible for PIPP Plus (150% of poverty)
- Have 12 consecutive months of electric usage at current address
- Annual baseload usage of at least 5,000 kWh







EPP is composed of two types of programs:

- A baseload efficiency program which audits lighting, appliance and all other uses not related to heating; and,
- 2. A weatherization program for those who heat with electric and who have high usage. This program may include adding insulation, performing heating system inspections, and addressing health and safety measures.

- Provides significant discounts on qualified energy efficiency upgrades...saves customers money for years to come
- A low-cost home energy analysis is part of the process








- Operated by CLEAResult; with home energy analysis' provided by both CLEAResult and COAD
- Energy efficiency upgrades are installed by trained, pre-qualified contractors
- Random inspections of work quality are performed through the program















As a part of "Weatherize Nelsonville", ALL individually-metered natural gas heating customers of Columbia Gas of Ohio residing in Nelsonville will automatically qualify for additional benefits from Columbia Gas of Ohio.







What Does this Mean?

- Home energy analysis for only \$20 (typically \$50) \$500 value
- Customer pays only \$300 towards air sealing, attic and wall insulation
- Instant discount of \$1,000 on high efficiency heating system upgrade

And, customers qualify regardless of income, just by being a resident of Nelsonville!







Discount eligible energy efficiency improvements

- Attic insulation
- Sidewall insulation
- Sealing of air leakage pathways
- 95% efficient, or greater, natural gas furnace or boiler

Improvements installed during energy analysis

- Programmable thermostat, if needed
- Energy efficient showerhead, if needed









AEP Ohio In-home Energy Program

- AEP Ohio offers a similar program for their customers
- All-electric customers eligible for a full home energy audit (\$50)
- Dual-fuel customers eligible for a home energy assessment (\$25)
- Both programs include the installation of free energy-saving items

And, Nelsonville customers serviced by both Columbia Gas of Ohio and AEP Ohio will receive all the benefits of the assessment program at no charge!







What Does this Mean?

- Customers who participate in the Columbia Gas of Ohio energy analysis (\$20) program will receive all of the following from AEP Ohio at no extra cost:
 - CFLs
 - LED night light
 - Smart strip
 - Additional rebate eligibility
 - Energy Star Central AC \$150-\$275

AEP Ohio All-electric Customers

- All-electric customers of AEP Ohio can benefit from a \$50 home energy audit
- Audit includes all direct installs, plus energy-efficient showerheads and faucet aerators
- Additional rebates toward qualified energy efficiency improvements, including:
 - \$150-\$275 toward ENERGY STAR Central AC
 - \$200-\$450 toward ENERGY STAR Heat Pump
 - \$1,200 toward ENERGY STAR Geothermal Heat Pump
 - Up for \$450 toward insulation
 - \$200 for air sealing
 - \$50 for duct sealing

Rebates for Business Customers

Innovative Energy Solutions "IES" Program

- All commercial customers are welcome
 - Corporation, sole-proprietorship, LLC, partnership, government, schools, non-profit, faith-based, manufacturing
- Available to existing customers
 - 12 months + gas usage
 - Including those purchasing gas through a third party
- Custom rebate program







IES Program

- Energy Audits
 - 50% the cost of an ASHRAE Level II or III audit
 - Capped at \$5,000 per project
- Energy Conservation Measures "ECMs"
 - Up to 50% of the installed cost
 - \$100,000 lifetime cap







IES Program

- Gas Energy Conservation Measures:
 - High efficiency condensing boilers, heat recovery, process improvements, solar thermal heat/pre-heat, duct sealing, energy management systems, HVAC equipment controls, thermostats, gasfired steam absorption chillers, domestic hot water system improvements, insulation
 - Not eligible: fuel-switching, CHP or "co-gen"















IES Project Eligibility

- Reservations are required for all audit and ECM rebates
 - "Pre-approval"
 - Engage with us early in the development process
 - Do not begin construction until your reservation is confirmed!
 - No rebates are available to projects that have been completed in the past







IES Instant Rebates

- Only available to customers using <300 Mcf (3,000 Ccf) per year
 - Rebate paid to contractor
 - Shows up as a discount on the invoice to the customer
 - "Prescriptive" measures
 - Showerheads, pre-rinse spray valves, aerators, water heaters, tank wraps, attic & wall insulation, air sealing, furnace/boiler, programmable t-stats, tubular radiant space heaters, & duct sealing
